# Wins Appeal in Bombing Case

TRENTON, Dec. 23.—George W. Rogers, 41 years old, hero of the Morro Castle fire, who is under sentence of twelve to twenty years for attempting to kill his superior officer with a home-made bomb while a member of the Bayonne Police Department, obtained a review of his conviction from the State Supreme Court today. The court granted a writ of error and set Jan. 11 for a hearing on the appeal of the former radio operator.
